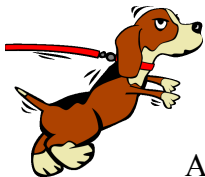

Provincial Government Sets Education Mill Rate

The province has determined the 2009 education property tax mill rates to be applied on a province-wide basis will be:

- For all agricultural property, 7.08 mills
- For all residential property, 10.08 mills
- For all commercial/industrial property;
 - On the first \$499,999 taxable assessment, 12.25 mills
 - On next \$5,500,000 taxable assessment, 15.75 mills
 - On any taxable assessment over \$5,999,999, 18.55 mills
